- **Call to Order** – Meeting called to Order by Dave Peterson, Nottawa Twp. Supervisor, at 6:04 pm
- **Pledge of Allegiance**
- **Roll Call of Attendees** – David Peterson, Jeff Wenzel, Dennis Allen were present, Patricia Boomer and Steve Wolf were absent.  
Shirley Betts, Jack Rote, Max McKelvey, and Dave Young from LTPOA Advisory also attended tonight’s meeting.
- **Rules of Meeting** – Please turn off cell phones or take calls outside of the meeting room. Comments are limited to 3 minutes.
- **Approval of today’s meeting agenda and the minutes from the July 11, 2024, LTIB meeting** – The minutes from July 11, 2024, meeting and the agenda items for tonight’s meeting were approved on a motion from Jeff Wenzel, supported by Dennis Allen and motion carried.
- **Treasurer’s Report** – Jeff Wenzel reported the County Treasurer Office LTIB Cash Balance as of July 11, 2024, was \$252,344.12 after today’s invoices are paid. The balance includes some 2024 SAD collection, still more tax funds are yet to be received. Any delinquent tax monies will be received into our account later this year.
- **Payment of Bills** – 7 bills, totaling \$122,214.86 were presented for payment. Easy Pro (2 bills) \$73,112.00 for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> A.O. lake treatments, Progressive AE (1 bill) \$4,000 for plant control, Solitude (3 bills) \$43,177.02 for Consulting, May 16th and June 13th treatments, Max McKelvey (1 Bill) \$1,925.84 reimbursement for new meter as old one unrepairable. A motion to approve by Dennis Allen, supported by Dave Peterson, motion carried.
- **Lake Templene Advisory Committee Report** – Jack Rote presented the report from the LTIB Advisory Committee.
  - a. Bio-augmentation Treatment: Easy Pro had Solitude apply the second and third bio-augmentation treatments.
  - b. Fish Enhancement: Boxes for Redear Sunfish catch/release fliers to be reinstalled at the boat launches and Findley Road bridge.

- c. Water Sampling: Dave Young and Max McKelvey to conduct Clamp water monitoring in 2024, will conduct as soon as new meter arrives.
- d. Aquatic Plant/Zebra Mussel Management:
  - The second aquatic plant survey was conducted by Progressive on June 3<sup>rd</sup>, the second treatment was conducted on June 13<sup>th</sup>. 25.5 acres was treated.
  - The third survey by Progressive was conducted July 9<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Zebra Mussel population will be evaluated when Docks are removed from the lake this fall.
