The Public Hearing is to consider Ordinance 56 to amend Nottawa Township Zoning Ordinance so as to add non-profit congregate and living facilities in the AR zoning district by setting forth requirements applicable to the use and to add site standards for the use into the zoning ordinance; to add regulations for inground swimming pools; and to add provisions and regulations for shared driveway and back lot access private drive; and to provide effective date; and to repeal conflicting ordinance provisions as follows:

Section 1. Renumbering provisions

Section 2. Adds definitions

Section 3. Adds to AR Agricultural Residential District a provision for Non-profit congregate and living facilities subject to special use.

Section 4. Adds to Section 300.500 a subsection with standards and site requirements for non-profit congregate and living facility for Special Use Permits

Section 5. Adds a new subsection of "General Provisions and Exceptions" to provide setbacks and requirements for swimming pools.

Section 6. Amends Section Five "Special Use Permits" by adding a new subsection with provisions and regulations for shared driveway and back lot access private drive.

Section 7. Effective Date and Repeal. The ordinance is effective on the 8th day after adoption.

A Public Hearing will also consider a Special Use Permit application by Russ Stauffer for a non-profit temporary rehabilitative housing facility, 27198 Marvin Rd, Centreville Michigan
